Lighthouse Educator Academy-**Year 1** At-a-Glance

July 30th - August 3rd: Pre-Opening - All certified staff new to Westside Community Schools will begin work on July 30th. This time allows teachers to work with mentors, participate in district level and building specific Professional Learning, complete online Professional Learning modules, and prepare their classrooms/course materials. A schedule for the 2018 – 2019 school year is as follows: Please see the Pre-opening calendar for more specifics about events July 30th – August 14th.

July 30th Superintendent and Human Resources Welcome Breakfast, at Swanson Elementary, 3534 S 108th St, Omaha, NE 68144 and lunch provided by the Westside Education Association (WEA). All staff will stay at Swanson for Technology Professional Learning in the afternoon.

July 31st - August 3rd are committed to meeting the needs of new staff and their responsibilities for the upcoming school year. Details are provided in the pre-opening calendar.

1st Year Lighthouse Educator Academy sessions – Academy members will participate in an in-depth study of Instructional Best Practices focusing on Madeline Hunter's Essential Elements of Instruction and Charlotte Danielson's, Framework for Teaching covering the four domains. (1. Planning and Preparation 2. The Classroom Environment 3. Instruction 4. Professional Responsibilities), and work by Anita Archer. The schedule of dates and topics for Academy members is as follows:

Technology Choice Session: Choose one after school tech training in addition to the February 20th SAMR meeting.

August 10th, All Day: Introduction to the Framework for Teaching at Underwood Hills with Sue Presler.

August 29th K-8 All Day: Classroom academy members / and special invites will request a full day guest teacher to engage in literacy discussions, an in-depth look at the Literacy Framework, and best practice for incorporating literacy across all content areas. 9-12 Staff building mentors will communicate your date, time, and place for this event.

September 19th 3:20 – 4:45 PM: Instructional Objectives – This seminar will cover the elements of writing a five-point objective in combination with Domain 1: Planning and Preparation from the Framework For Teaching and 3a –Communicating with Students. February 20th, 3:20 4:45: Understanding of the SAMR model and how it pertains to student learning with Dr. Matt Lee at Underwood Hills Elementary.
